

## **MOVE PROGRAM**

### **Muhlenberg On-line Virtual Education**

The MOVE Program is an alternative learning program for students grades 9-12 with any of the following circumstances:

- Economic hardship
- Significantly behind in high school credits
- Physical or mental health conditions
- Drop-outs

Students' enrollment will be at the Renaissance Center. The MOVE program is aligned with high school standards. Students will be allowed to work at home and/or in the MOVE lab during regular school hours. Students accepted into this program must be self-motivated and determined to put in the time and effort to complete their requirements on time and successfully maintain recommended progress. Academic performance will be evaluated at mid-term of each nine-week period to determine if the student remains eligible to continue in this program.

\*2021-2022 academic performance and participation **MAY** impact acceptance into the MOVE program.

#### **Application Process**

- Parent/student must complete MOVE application
- Application is reviewed by MOVE committee
- If accepted, parent/student conference is required with MOVE coordinator before enrollment

For parents and students applying for the MOVE Program due to mental health reasons, the following criteria must be met:

- Minimum of two documented conferences with either the student's principal/assistant principal or school counselor regarding the student's reason for applying for the MOVE program
- Minimum of 2 documented visits with psychiatrist, psychologist, or licensed mental health counselor prior to application date
- A letter or statement of reference by a psychiatrist, psychologist, or licensed mental health counselor supporting the student's reason for applying for the MOVE program
- Possible parent/student conference with the MOVE committee

#### **Extracurricular Events**

Students enrolled at the Renaissance Center cannot participate in extracurricular activities: sports, band, clubs, JROTC, prom, other dances, etc. that are high school affiliated. Students can attend games and participate in graduation ceremonies.
